

## **Neighbors Credit Union Youth Week 2017, Win A Sky Zone Trampoline Park Pass (\$50 Value) Contest Rules**

1. Sponsor: Neighbors Credit Union, St. Louis, Missouri.
2. Eligible Participants: Credit Union Camp Cash and My.Bux who are age 19 years of age and younger during Youth Month, April 1-29, 2017. Entrants who submit an official entry form after making a deposit into their Camp Cash or My.Bux account during Youth month and who are a U.S. Citizen. Subject to paragraph 1 below.
3. How to Enter: Credit union members 19 years of age and younger must make at least a \$50 deposit during Youth Month. The contest begins April 1, 2017 and ends April 29, 2017. An eligible participant is entered for the Contest when they submit an entry form at any Neighbors Credit Union branch between April 1, 2017 and April 29, 2017 by 1:00 pm. Entries become the property of Neighbors Credit Union and will not be returned.
4. Drawing: On May 1, 2017. One official entry form will be selected from the entry box at each Neighbors Credit Union branch (8). The entry forms selected on May 1, 2017, will be the winners.
5. Eligibility Exceptions and General Terms: Employees and volunteer officials of Neighbors Credit Union, and their immediate families (spouse, parents, children, siblings and their spouses) and individuals living in the same household of each of the above are ineligible. Contest void where prohibited or restricted by law. Federal, state, and local taxes are sole responsibility of the prizewinner. Contest is subject to all applicable federal, state (Missouri) and local laws and regulations. No substitutions or transfers of prize permitted except at sole discretion of Sponsor.
